- 2 Canned Fruit
 - 10-12 Canned Vegetables and Beans
 - 2 Pasta and 2 Pasta Sauce
 - 1 bag Brown Rice
 - 1-2 Boxes of Cereal (if available)
 - 1 Powdered/Evaporated Milk
 - 3 Corn Meal Mix
 - 3 Macaroni and Cheese
 - 1 Sugar
 - 1 Peanut Butter
 - 2 Canned Meat
(Soup with meat, chili, tuna, meat sauce, etc...)
- If available, drink mix, snack items, paper towels, napkins
Make sure that barcodes are marked out
